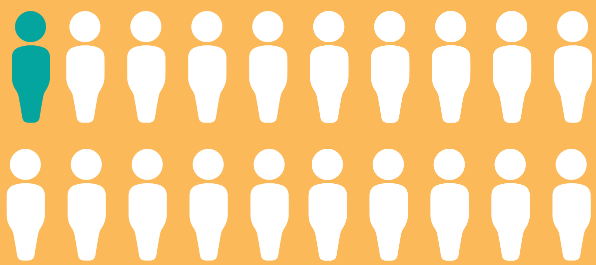


Early Years

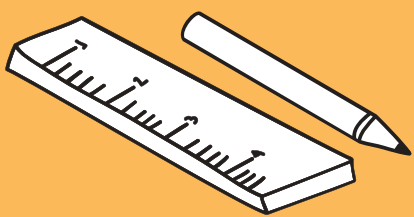
children under 16 in the UK is disabled
